Volunteer Opportunity

Volunteer registration is now open for Rhode Island Mission of Mercy Free Dental Clinic (**RIMOM**) that takes place on September 24 & 25 at the Providence Community Health Center's Prairie Avenue Dental Clinic.

RIMOM is a two-day FREE dental clinic is held once a year and provides free dental services to the uninsured, underinsured or anyone who cannot access dental care. At the clinic, patients receive a health and dental screening and are then provided treatment based on their oral health needs. Services at RIMOM include cleanings, fillings, x-rays, tooth extractions, root canal treatment (on front teeth only), oral health instructions, small denture repairs and a limited number of partial dentures to replace missing front teeth. Services are provided at RIMOM are on a first-come, first-served basis.

RIMOM is looking for volunteers including dentists, dental hygienists, dental assistants and medical professionals. There is also a great need for non-dental/medical volunteers.

These opportunities include interpreters, patient escorts, patient and volunteer check-in and food service support.

RIMOM's greatest non-dental/medical volunteer need is interpreters, as well as bilingual volunteers in any of the above volunteer opportunities.
